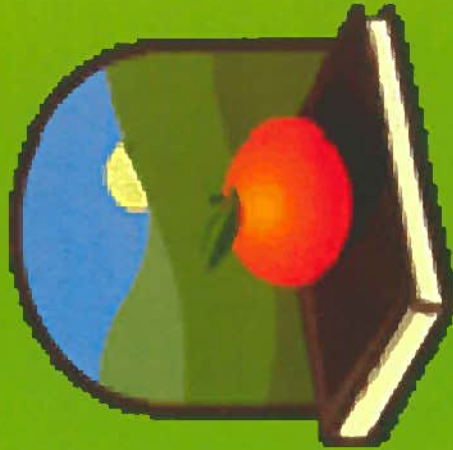


OUR VISION
