



Welcome to the 2017-2018 school year!

Students who were free or reduced during the 2016-2017 school year will remain at the same status for the first 30 operating days of the 2017-2018 school year *or* until a new application has been processed. The new status will go into effect immediately and will supersede carryover eligibility. If a new application is not received/processed by Monday October 2, 2017, students will go to a full-paid status on Tuesday October 3, 2017. Students who are at a full-paid status are required to pay for their meals until an application has been processed. *This year, students who are approved for reduced price meals will receive their meals at no cost.*
